These projects and assignments will be counted as your first assignment for the new school year. This work will be due when you return to school on Wednesday, August 22nd.

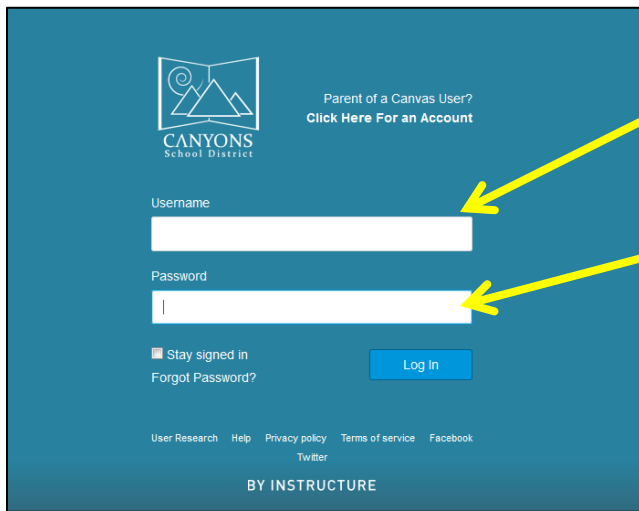
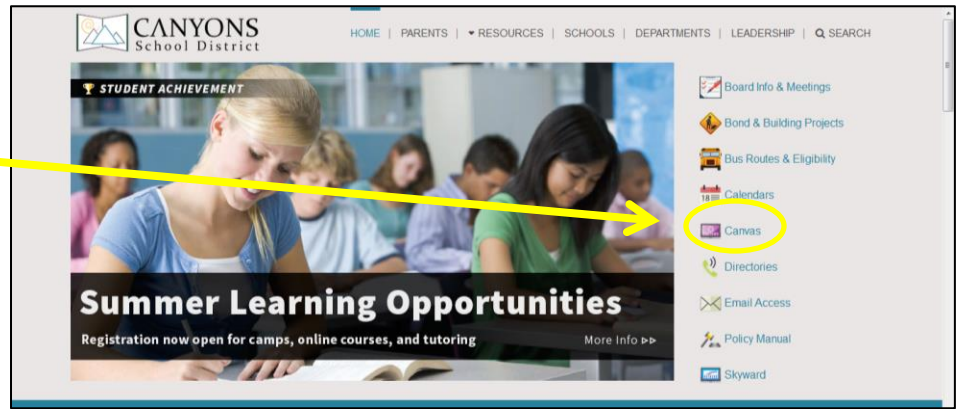

Go to the Canyons School District website (www.canyonsdistrict.org). Select CANVAS from the right sidebar menu.



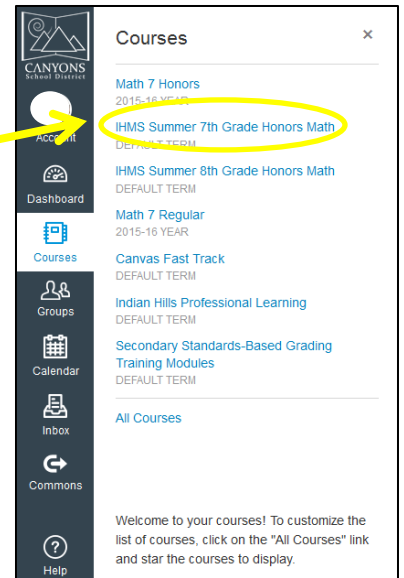
Login with your usual login information:

Username: first letter of your first name + first three letters of your last name + last four digits of your student ID number (no spaces)

Password: student ID number

Select the “Courses” menu in the upper left hand corner of the screen and select the summer honors course for your grade. (These courses will open on June 11th, so you will not be able to see this link before then.)

After you do this, you will see the home page for your course.
