### **Administrative Presentations**

- Digital Citizenship – Mr. Evans reported there will be a Netsmarts assembly in January or February. Mr. Evans puts out a monthly media message to teachers which will not be available on the Indian Hills website. There will be a parental resource tab entitled “Digital Citizenship.”
- 2017-2018 Land Trust Results – Mr. Graham handed out the report that details what was budgeted versus what was actually spent out of land trust monies. The committee discussed the discrepancy in math inventory scores throughout the grades. The discrepancy could be due to moving to a seven period day with shorter class periods.

### **Discussion Items**

- PT Conference Totals – 63% overall attendance with 6<sup>th</sup> grade having the highest attendance overall. There was a discussion about how parents liked the open house style rather than having students lead the conference. The question was asked about how other schools conduct conferences. The idea was given about inviting D and F students to attend conferences.
- Police Dog Training – Sandy City police would like to conduct police dog trainings periodically. This would be done while students were in classes. It was put to a vote and was approved unanimously.
- Amendment for Extra Funds -- \$27, 159 was spent on three Chromebook carts and headphones for all Chromebook carts in the building.
